

Uniform / Clothing Pool Update April 2017

Please note that there have been changes to the Farrer winter school uniform which will come into effect from Term 2 of 2017. This will mean that the students will wear grey trousers and a white shirt with a tie as their day-to-day school uniform.

The Clothing Pool has ample stock of new grey trousers and white shirts for sale. White shirts sell @ \$27 for all sizes. Greys vary in price; for the smaller sizes 10-14 they sell @ \$50 per pair and the larger sizes sell @ \$55 per pair. In addition, we have reasonable stocks of second-hand greys across all sizes.

Jumpers are now in stock for the cooler weather. They are priced @ \$75 for sizes 12-16 and \$83 for the larger sizes. We also have our soft shell jackets, priced @ \$115. The boys can wear these jackets over the top of their jumpers for extra warmth from Monday to Friday.

Track tops and pants are also now in stock. Track tops range in price from \$50 for sizes 12-16 and the larger sizes @ \$60 each. Pants range in price from \$30-\$35 again depending on the size.

Please note that during Term 2, the Clothing Pool will continue to operate each **Monday only** from 10.30am to 2.00pm. Nikki Hansen
